## **Female Attire**

**Ballet/Pointe** – bodysuit & salmon tights

Tap/Jazz/Lyrical/Contemporary/Acro/Hip Hop/ Jumps & Turns/ Musical Theatre/POM/Rec Jazz – Students have the option to dress in a bodysuit, shorts, tank top, tee shirt, leggings, capri pants, and bra tops. Please avoid baggy clothing.

Male dancers: Black shoes & socks, black shorts & a tee shirt for all classes

## Hair

Ballet - Slicked back ballet bun

Acro - Low Ponytail, Pigtails, Braids (Preferably)

Tap/Jazz/Lyrical/Contemporary/ Hip Hop/Jumps & Turns/ Musical Theatre/POM/Rec Jazz – Any hairstyle as long as it is pulled back and out of the way. Ex. ponytail, pigtails, braids, bun

## **Shoes**

**Ballet** - Pink Leather Ballet Slippers (Beginner/Pre-Primary/Primary) Split sole canvas Capezio brand ballet slippers (Grade 1 & up)

**Tap** - Beige Capezio Strap-on Low Heel Tap Shoes (Beginner - Junior). Black Lace Up Tap Shoes (Intermediate & Advanced).

**Jazz/Jumps & Turns** – Beige Capezio Slip-on Jazz Shoes (Beginner-Junior) Beige Half Sole Capezio Turners (Intermediate & Advanced)

Lyrical/Contemporary – Beige Half Sole Capezio Turners

**Large Group** - Beige Half Sole Capezio Turners

Acro - No shoes required

HipHop/POM/Rec Jazz- Clean All Black Running Shoes

**Musical Theatre** - No specific shoes for regular weekly classes. Shoes for performance will be specified during the season.



Please Note: Exam Attire may differ and will be specified closer to exam dates.

Recital Finale - All dancers will be required to wear their SODC finale shirt and black shorts. Footwear will depend on the styles of dance included in the finale and the age level, with the majority opting for bare feet.
